

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Saturday 16 Nov 2013

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Outbreaks of rain moves slowly southeastwards over Scotland and Northern Ireland through the day. Elsewhere, largely dry but becoming increasingly cloudy from the northwest, the best of any sunshine in southeast England. Overnight, rain moving south into Wales and central England. To the south, largely cloudy, although early clear spells in far southeast. Clear, frosty in the north.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:  
Scattered showers and sunny spells in the north for much of the day. Elsewhere, mostly cloudy with patchy outbreaks of rain, heavy over western upslopes overnight. Rain clearing southwards late Monday with much colder conditions following in the north, with wintry showers.
