Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Generally drier, sunnier and less windy than Wednesday, with well-scattered showers. The showers will mainly affect western areas during the morning before developing further east later, with sunny spells continuing. Winds will increase later in the day, ahead of heavy rain reaching the far southwest by evening, while heavy showers also move into the northwest.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Spells of persistent and occasionally heavy rain will affect parts of southern UK on Friday, with the north staying brighter but with showers. Saturday should then be a largely dry and fine day, with plenty of sunshine, although the northeast may retain a few showers.
