Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Dry and chilly in the east initially, but rain already in the west will move eastwards through today, with some heavy bursts expected, and also some snow over northern hills. Conditions will turn more showery from the west later. Generally windy. Staying mostly showery and windy tonight, with gales in the southwest.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Plenty of cloud will bring showery outbreaks of rain to most parts on Sunday, but with some drier conditions at times too, especially to the north. Gales are expected in the south, with severe gales in the southwest. Plenty of fine weather will spread eastwards during Monday.
