Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Rain will affect eastern Scotland and England at first, otherwise a fresher day for most with sunshine and showers; these heaviest across Scotland and Northern Ireland with a risk of thunder. Fewer showers elsewhere and feeling warm but less humid than recently.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Sunshine and showers are set to continue through Sunday although many central areas will remain dry. The heaviest showers will be in the North where we could again hear some thunder. Monday will turn wet and windy with some torrential rain and the risk of gales spreading from the southwest.
