Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
A dry, fine day for most with lots of sunshine, this perhaps hazy at times. Across northern Scotland, however, much more cloud is expected with showers affecting the Hebrides. Later, outbreaks of rain will move across some mainland parts of northwest Scotland. A frosty start for many but it should not feel too bad in the sunshine this afternoon.

Rain will continue to move across Scotland this evening, reaching Northern Ireland and some parts of northern England overnight. Dry and frosty elsewhere with some mist and fog patches.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:
Generally dry and settled with variable cloud and some sunshine.
