

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A bright, frosty start for most of England and Wales. However Scotland, Northern Ireland, far northern Wales and far eastern England will have a cloudy morning with isolated light showers. Persistent rain all day over northern Scotland extends to Northern Ireland through the evening and night, whilst bands of light showers affect northern England and Wales.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:
Cloudy everywhere on Wednesday with light northerly winds and scattered light showers. A band of more persistent rain will sweep southwards over west Wales and then Devon and Cornwall. Cloudy with strengthening northeasterlies on Thursday, bringing widespread rain to central parts.
