Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Outbreaks of rain across Northern Ireland initially will gradually move southeast across Wales and central parts of England. Fine to the south of this for most of the day, though cooler than Tuesday, and sunny spells with showers to the north of the rainband.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Most places will see sunny spells and scattered showers. The showers will be most prevalent, blustery and perhaps heavy at times in the north and east while the southwest stays generally drier and brighter. Temperatures will be around normal, but it may feel cool in the east at times.
