

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Saturday 24 Oct 2015

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain, locally heavy with strong winds, will move south-eastwards, clearing the far southeast this evening. Clearer, colder and sunnier conditions will follow, with scattered showers, these heavy and thundery towards the northwest. Further showers are expected in the northwest tonight whilst it'll be dry elsewhere with clear skies, under which it'll turn colder than last night with a slight frost.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

It will be windy across the north and northwest of Scotland with some rain on Sunday and Monday. Away from here it'll stay largely dry with lengthy periods of sunshine. Although further rain will reach southwestern parts later on Monday.
