

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Fog in central and southwestern areas will clear to leave a dry day for many with plenty of sunshine. Meanwhile the light rain in southeastern England will clear during the afternoon. During the evening and overnight, intermittent rain will move east across the UK, with showers following along western coasts. Strong southerly winds will affect Scotland and Northern Ireland.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

It will remain unsettled with occasional rain in southeast England on Tuesday, with bright spells and showers elsewhere. Rain or showers should become mainly confined to England and Wales on Wednesday. Remaining windy with a risk of gales in the northwest.
