Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
After a frosty start for some, Sunday promises to be largely dry with sunny spells and light winds. It'll feel warm in the sunshine but eastern parts of England may see more cloud and the chance of a few showers. Tonight it'll be mostly dry though, with pockets of frost. Some fog is also possible, especially in the southeast.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

It'll be windy on Monday in the northwest, with some rain. For many it will be dry with long sunny spells, but the rain will move in later. The rain will then clear the southeast on Tuesday, leaving bright spells.
