

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Sunny intervals and scattered showers for Northern Ireland and northwest Scotland, with sunny spells and isolated light showers elsewhere. Temperatures generally near normal, although becoming rather warm across the southeast of England. This evening and overnight heavy rain will spread across Northern Ireland, Scotland and northern England, with broken cloud and showers following. Elsewhere overnight becoming largely cloudy with showers.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Sunday sunny spells and mainly light showers, with the showers mainly across northern parts of the UK. Through the evening rain will reach western Scotland. Monday southern England staying mostly dry. Elsewhere outbreaks of rain and becoming windy. Feeling cooler.
