

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Wednesday 11 May 2011

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Starting cloudier than of late, particularly in the north and west. Occasionally heavy showers and brisk southwesterly winds are expected here from dawn, with sunny intervals. Elsewhere, sunny spells developing, with afternoon showers possible for all parts, including the southeast. Overnight, showers dying away for most to leave a dry night, however the northwest will see further showery rain.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

The risk of occasionally heavy showers will continue towards the weekend, with showers particularly affecting northwestern UK, but also extending to other areas at times, with sunny spells also expected countrywide. Becoming cooler than of late, with brisk westerly winds.
