

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Saturday 07 Jul 2012

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Very wet in parts of southwest England, with heavy, persistent rain for much of the day, easing somewhat later. Central and eastern Scotland also seeing persistent rain. Elsewhere, sunny spells and scattered showers, some heavy or thundery. Overnight, outbreaks of rain continuing in many areas, with northern Scotland and Northern Ireland seeing the most persistent rain.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

On Sunday, northern Scotland staying wet, with parts of northeast England perhaps also seeing fairly heavy rain. Elsewhere, sunny intervals and heavy showers. On Monday, outbreaks of rain for many areas, but drier and brighter interludes probable too, mainly in the northwest and southwest.
