REMARKS.

Over our islands the barometrical pressures are considerably greater than they were on Saturday, having steadily increased since the afternoon of that day. The difference in pressure between northern and southern stations is large, amounting to upwards of 6 tenths of an inch.

Temperature diminished yesterday over our islands, but this morning it is again rather high except in the N. of Scotland.

On Saturday night a heavy gale from the S.W. blew in the Bay of Biscay, and in the English and Irish Channels; and continued to blow yesterday with a north-westerly direction in the S. of Ireland and in the S.W. of England. The wind this morning is fresh from the N.W. on the Irish Coast, but moderate in the English Channel.

Rain fell in large amount on the S. Coast of England on Saturday night. Mist prevails in places on our coasts, and weather is generally overcast.

2 P.M. Since the morning an increase in barometrical pressure has taken place on all our coasts with a continuance of northwesterly winds

REMARKS.

Barometrical pressures were reported yesterday afternoon as increasing on all our coasts: this increase has continued on our S and E coasts till this morning, but in the W. of Ireland a decrease is showing itself. Pressures are still generally high, with considerable differences existing between places in the N and S. — that between Nairn and Rockport is more than half an inch.

Temperature has risen in the N and W, and is high at all stations.

Winds yesterday were generally north westerly, and fresh in the W. and SW of these islands; but have since backed to the SW. on the western and southern coasts of Ireland, and are generally of moderate force.

Much fog has prevailed on our southern and western coasts. Rain is now falling on the E. coast of Scotland, and weather is generally overcast.

REMARKS.

The depression in barometrical pressure over our islands commencing yesterday, and which was noticeable last evening, has continued; but on the W. coast of France a slight increase is shown. The change since yesterday has been greatest in Scotland; and in the extreme north, where pressures are rather low, the reading is nearly 9 tenths of an inch less than that at Rochefort.

Temperature ~~in the south of England~~ ^{has fallen in Scotland} ~~has risen~~ ^{but} and is generally high at the southern stations.

Winds during the last 24 hours have been westerly: they have been strong in the south of Ireland, and increased, last evening, to a gale at Ardrossan. On the Irish coast the wind, from the SW, is still fresh; but on our other coasts it is generally moderate.

In the south and west mist and fog are reported, whilst rain has fallen in the N.W. of our islands.

In the N. of Scotland the weather is fine, but elsewhere it is cloudy or overcast.

REMARKS.

There has been a large diminution of barometrical pressure at all stations since yesterday, which has been greatest on the East coast of England. Since last evening the readings in the South of England show a rapid decrease, while in Scotland the fall has been less considerable, and pressure has begun to recover itself at Nairn and Leith. The difference between readings at Aberdeen and Rochefort exceeds 1 inch.

Temperature on our South and West coasts is high, but in the north, where a diminution has occurred, it is low.

The violent south-westerly winds, which were reported yesterday afternoon as blowing at Penzance, have continued during the night, prevailing on the Irish coast and in the Irish and English Channels. A gale is still blowing from the westward in the English Channel, but on the coasts of Ireland and Scotland the wind has veered to the N.W., and has moderated.

Rain has fallen generally: it has been very heavy on the Irish coast, where fog and mist are noticeable. The sea is high in the English Channel.

Warnings were issued yesterday.

2 P.M. Barometrical pressures are slightly increasing except in the South of England, whilst the wind continues westerly and strong at the Entrance of the Channel.

REMARKS.

In France there has been a decrease in barometrical pressure since yesterday morning. Its extent at Lyons has been more than half an inch, but over these islands a general rise has taken place, which has been greatest in the West. In the N. of Scotland pressures are still low, and readings there are nearly $\frac{7}{10}$ of an inch lower than those on the W. Coast of France.

Temperatures are generally lower: those in the S.E. of England show a considerable decrease.

The westerly winds of yesterday freshened again last night, and increased to a gale on the W. Coast of Ireland, and in the English Channel. This morning a high westerly wind is reported at Holyhead; but in the English Channel and on the S.W. coast of Ireland the wind is fresh from the N.W.

Hail has fallen at Greencastle, and the weather has been squally, with hail showers, at Brussels; whilst rain has fallen generally over our islands. This morning fine weather is reported from the E. coasts of England and Scotland.

REMARKS.

The sudden change of ^{barometrical} pressure which set in on Saturday extended to all stations, and the oscillations have been most violent, amounting to upwards of 8 tenths of an inch of rise and fall in Scotland. In Ireland a fresh rapid decrease has begun since last evening: elsewhere a rise, as yet, is noticeable. Pressures are generally low, with a difference of readings of half an inch between those at Vairn and Rochefort.

Temperatures have not changed much during the last 24 hours.

On Saturday a northwesterly squall set in at mid-day at Greenecastle: it moderated by 2 P.M., but increased in extent and violence very seriously after that hour, and very severe W and NW gales were felt yesterday in both the English and Irish Channels.

Warnings were issued on Saturday evening. This morning a moderate southwesterly wind prevails in the West: in the S. of England it is calm.

Hail storms with rain have prevailed generally over these islands. Mist is also reported this morning from several stations both on our W & E. Coasts.

REMARKS.

The increase in the barometrical pressure, commencing yesterday afternoon, has been general, and has been most rapid in the S.W. of Ireland, where readings are higher by upwards of 6 tenths of an inch. In the northern portions of these islands pressures are still low, the readings there being much below those at southern stations: the difference between Kairn and Lyons is now more than 8 tenths.

A small and general diminution in temperature has taken in our islands.

In the N. of Ireland the northerly wind, freshening yesterday afternoon, increased to a gale during the night, whilst a southerly gale has passed over the Irish and English Channels. Strong westerly winds are now blowing on the Irish coast, but in the English Channel the wind has veered to the westward, and has moderated.

Rain has fallen generally over our islands: it has been heavy on the Irish Coast and in the N.E. of Scotland. Squalls of hail are reported from Valencia, and at C. Clear the sea is high.

2 P.M.: Pressures have risen rapidly on all coasts except at Valencia, where the increase since the morning is but slight. Winds have become more southerly in the S.W. of our islands. A high sea is reported in the Channel.

REMARKS.

At Valencia the increase is only 0.13 inch. This change has been accompanied by a great and general rise of temperature. The difference of readings between Nairn and Lyons is 1.13 inch, while the reading at Valencia is 4 tenths below that at D'armouth.

Winds yesterday evening backed to S.W. at Valencia, and they increased to a gale on the western coasts of Ireland, and on the southern coasts of Scotland. The wind is still very strong from the southward in the S.W. of Ireland and in the Irish Sea, but in the English Channel the prevailing wind is southwest and fresh.

Fog is reported from the south and west four islands, where the fall of rain has been greatest. The sea is high in the S.W. of Ireland. Weather is unsettled.

Warnings were issued yesterday afternoon.

There has been a diminution in temperature, the greatest change having been in Scotland and Ireland.

REMARKS.

Tuesday. Barometrical pressure has recovered itself at the northern and western stations since yesterday, the change being greatest at Valencia; while a decrease is shown at other stations increasing regularly in amount to Stelder, where it is nearly 4 tenths. The difference of readings between Nairn and Rochefort is 7 tenths, while that at Stelder is 4 tenths below that at Valencia. Temperature has considerably diminished in the N and W: it is generally lower than it was yesterday morning.

High southwesterly winds were felt yesterday in the Irish Channel and on the S. coast of Ireland, where the wind has now veered to the NW and is blowing a gale. On our other coasts fresh northwesterly winds prevail, but at Stelder the wind is strong from the SW.

Rain has been general since yesterday: the greatest amount was observed at Irish and Scotch stations. Hail is reported at Valencia. Fog and mist have prevailed on our western and southern stations.

2 P.M.: On all our coasts pressure has increased since the morning, and very rapidly in the N and NW. Winds on our western coasts continue to blow from the Northwestward.

Winds yesterday were fresh from NW to NE on our southern coast, and in the afternoon increased to a squall from the N. at Yarmouth. Light and variable winds now prevail in Scotland and Ireland: the direction on the Channel coast is NE.

Fog prevails at Holyhead, and mist is reported from Plymouth. On our E. coast the weather is fine, but elsewhere the sky is generally cloudy.
