Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Rain persisting across much of northwest then northern Scotland.
Elsewhere showers, some prolonged and also heavy, with thunder at times across southern England. Later showers becoming isolated and lighter in many places. Temperatures generally slightly above average.

This evening cloud and outbreaks of rain will extend across the rest of Scotland, reaching northern Ireland and later north Wales. Elsewhere many places becoming dry with clear spells.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Tuesday - Largely cloudy with showers or outbreaks of rain across northern Wales and Northern Ireland. Scattered showers northern England, isolated showers and sunny intervals elsewhere.

Wednesday - sunny intervals and isolated light showers.
