Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
It will be a mostly dry day across the UK with some sunshine, although any early mist or fog patches may be slow to clear through the morning. Isolated showers continuing in east and southeast England. Cloudier in the north, with some showers in the far north.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:  
It is likely to remain mostly dry with variable amounts of cloud and sunshine during Sunday and Monday. A few showers though are likely at times, these will be mainly around eastern coasts. Overnight it will turn cold and frosty where skies remain clear with some mist and freezing fog patches also developing.
