Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Spells of heavy showery rain mainly affecting northern, western and southern parts, with a risk of hill snow over Scottish Mountains. There'll be some sunshine too but feeling chilly, with winds strengthening later, particularly in north-east Scotland with coastal gales. A local frost in northern and western areas overnight with gales and showers persisting.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Both days will be generally cold, dry and breezy with gales along the east coast. Locally heavy showers around northern, western and eastern coasts, wintry over hills and possible thunder in the north, but plenty of sunny spells elsewhere. Overnight frosts generally becoming more widespread.
