Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :  
Most places will start frosty with some patchy freezing fog, but these will clear to leave most places sunny with any light showers across the far southeast dying out. However, cloud and a little rain across northwest Scotland will spread southwards, reaching roughly Wales to Norfolk by evening. It will become rather breezy across the north.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

There will be some sunshine, especially in the east, otherwise it will often be cloudy, but mostly dry, save a little rain in the north and west. Stronger winds will bring heavier rain to the north later on Thursday.
