

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Saturday 04 Dec 2010

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:

A cold, grey day with most places seeing outbreaks of rain, sleet or snow at times. This will be mainly rain in southern areas, heavy in far southeast England, but snow in northern Scotland, spreading southwards to other parts of Scotland, northern England and Northern Ireland overnight. Temperatures falling rapidly after dark, leading to a risk of widespread ice.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Wintry showers for areas exposed to the north, most frequent in northwest Scotland, but otherwise mainly dry with sunshine in places. Staying bitterly cold though as northerly winds return to many areas, with severe overnight frosts and freezing fog in places.
