

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Thursday 07 Feb 2008

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Rain will linger over much of Scotland, heaviest in the west. Elsewhere, mostly cloudy, mild, with patchy drizzle in places, but also a few brighter spells developing in the southeast. The rain will become locally heavy with gales across Scotland tonight, whilst skies start to clear across much of England and Wales.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:  
Northwest Britain will continue cloudy and rather damp at times, but elsewhere it should be mostly fine and dry with variable amounts of cloud. The best of the sunshine will be in the south and east, but this will lead to patchy frost and fog by night.
