

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Southeastern parts of England should have a generally dry day with plenty of sunny spells. Elsewhere, it is likely to be cloudier with outbreaks of light rain spreading slowly east across the country, although rain should clear Northern Ireland by the evening. Winds will be light west or southwesterlies, with temperatures remaining around normal.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
It is likely to remain rather cloudy with occasional light rain or showers, but also some sunny spells, the best of these towards eastern parts of the UK. Winds should stay light, with temperatures expected to become very warm in southeast England on Monday.
