Headline:

Mostly dry overnight. Rain moving south across Scotland on Wednesday.

This Evening and Tonight:

Perhaps a few light showers, mainly near to eastern coasts, but most parts will be dry. A slight frost is likely in places.

Wednesday:

Many places remaining dry with bright or sunny spells expected, despite a fair amount of cloud. However, a band of rain will move southwards across Scotland during the day.

Outlook for Thursday:

Rain in south soon clearing. Bright spells developing.
