Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :  
It will remain cloudy and wet across northeast England and eastern Scotland, whilst rain across some central areas of Scotland will clear. Elsewhere, there will already be showers across southwestern areas, and further showers will develop during the day. These will be heaviest across central and southern areas through the afternoon. Temperatures will be lowest in the cloudier east, perhaps up to warm locally in the south.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:  
There will be little change through Sunday, still cloudy, cool across eastern areas, rain or showers developing elsewhere. A better day on Monday, dry with sunny spells for many. Temperatures slowly improving.
