Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Many eastern parts of the UK will have a dry, bright start. However, western areas will see plenty of showers, these gradually spreading to eastern areas. The showers are also likely to merge, giving longer spells of rain later. Bright spells and showers across Scotland and Northern Ireland with snow over higher hills. Severe gales across northwest Scotland. Feeling cold.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Rain spreading northeast across much of England and Wales during Monday. Drier, brighter across southern Scotland and Northern Ireland but wet and windy over northwest Scotland with some significant snow for higher hills. Bright spells and scattered showers on Tuesday.
