

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Sunday 15 May 2011

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Brisk westerly winds and occasional rain will spread in from the west during the morning to affect much of the northern and particularly northwestern UK. Meanwhile southern Britain should stay mainly dry with sunny periods at first, but becomes increasingly cloudy as the day progresses.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Remaining unsettled towards the north and west into the new working week, with spells of rain, heavy at first, and occasionally brisk westerly winds at times, giving a cool feel. Further south, drier conditions should prevail, with temperatures continuing in a similar vein to present, and with the best brightness towards the southeast.
