

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Largely cloudy with outbreaks of rain. Some sleet or light snow is possible, mainly across central parts of England. The best of any brighter spells are most likely across the far east. Overnight, rain will turn heavier across western parts, with patchy sleet and snow continuing across central areas. Patchy ice or frost developing under clearer spells.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Remaining cold and cloudy with outbreaks of rain and snow on Sunday. Snow becoming heavier and potentially disruptive over central and northern parts of England and Wales later in the day and overnight into Monday. Slowly becoming drier on Monday but remaining cold.
