Forecast for the UK.
Issued by the Met Office
at 0700 on Friday 28 January 2005

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Outbreaks of rain or drizzle will persist across southeastern areas,
although becoming drier in the west. Remaining areas will stay
largely dry, although patchy drizzle will affect north-facing coasts
at times. Still rather cloudy tonight, and more patchy drizzle will
affect eastern and some central areas. A few clear spells though in
the west. Windy today, but temperatures generally mild.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Drizzle will still affect northern and eastern areas on Saturday, but
then the sunny intervals being enjoyed by sheltered southern and
southwestern parts will arrive here too. Most places will be dry by
then. Temperatures, similar, but the winds lighter.
