Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:

A band of locally heavy rain and strong to gale force winds in the north and west will gradually move southeast through the day, slowly easing and reaching southeast England by the evening. Drier and brighter conditions, with lighter winds, will follow with a few showers developing in the northwest.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

After a chilly and frosty start, Wednesday will be mostly dry and sunny, but become wet and windy once more in the northwest. Thursday will be breezy and rather cloudy. A little light rain or drizzle is possible, mainly over western hills. However, elsewhere it will be predominantly dry.
