at 1945 on Sunday 04 Aug 2013

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
Blustery outbreaks of rain persist through the morning in the west, before spreading northeastwards later. These will be heavy at times, bringing the risk of localised flooding. This band of rain then clears through the afternoon, with drier and brighter weather following. Elsewhere, staying mostly dry with sunny spells, although showers will continue over Scotland.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Generally dry but cloudy with light winds. A few light showers are possible on Tuesday, mainly in the north and west. whilst on Wednesday there is the potential for isolated slow moving, heavy and perhaps thundery showers to develop. Temperatures remaining near average.
