

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Tuesday 10 Aug 2010

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Persistent rain in southern England will gradually clear eastwards during the day, but thundery showers are expected across Scotland and northern England. It should be mostly dry and fine elsewhere. Overnight, much of England, Wales and Northern Ireland should remain dry and cool with occasional rain elsewhere. However, heavier rain is expected to reach northern Scotland through the early hours.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Rain or showers will spread from Scotland into northern England by late afternoon, but it should be mostly dry elsewhere, with isolated light showers and bright spells. Outbreaks of rain are expected across northeastern parts of the UK on Thursday.
