

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Friday 10 Jan 2014

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A bright, chilly start for many but also some icy patches first thing. Cloud and patchy rain spreading slowly eastwards, but not reaching southeast England until after dark. A few showers in the south and then in northwestern parts later. The showers in the north may turn heavy and wintry at times overnight.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Saturday, any rain clearing the far southeast to leave a mostly dry, sunny day after a cold start for many. Wintry showers in the northwest slowly easing. Sunday will start bright and dry after a frosty start with fog patches, but rain will spread east later.
