Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :  
Blizzards across Scotland, particularly the east. Sheltered southern parts may see little snow. Frequent snow showers also in Northern Ireland and northeast England, with further sleet/snow crossing England and Wales, followed by snow showers in North Wales. Southeastern counties should be drier and brighter at times. Feeling bitterly cold, particularly in north and east, where winds are strongest.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:  
Continuing cold on Thursday with snow showers in east, rain or sleet in northwest. A few showers in west, but plenty of sunshine as well. Wintry showers in north Scotland on Friday. Sunny start elsewhere, then rain spreading from west. Southwest milder.
