Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Scotland, Northern Ireland and northern England will be dry with some  
sunshine after a frosty start, but patchy fog will be slow to clear.  
Elsewhere, it will be dull, damp and misty with hill fog, though some  
brightness is likely for west Wales and later southeast England. It  
will turn colder in the southeast.

Tonight will be mostly cloudy with a little drizzle in places, though  
any cloud breaks will allow for a local frost.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

It will be mostly cloudy or dull with outbreaks of drizzle or light  
snow, and it will feel increasingly cold and raw in easterly winds.
