Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Scotland, Northern Ireland and northern England will have variable cloud and some sunny spells with any showers becoming confined to the far north of Scotland. It will be fairly mild, but windy with some strong gusts east of the Pennines especially. Wales and the rest of England will start with a widespread frost, otherwise the day will be dry with plenty of hazy sunshine and with just light winds.

Tonight, it will be mostly dry. It will be quite mild in the windy north, but southern areas will have another widespread frost along with some patchy fog.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Some rain for northern Scotland, otherwise dry with some sunshine once patchy fog across central and southern areas clears.
