




Yellow warning

Further snow is expected for parts of Scotland on Tuesday.

What to expect

- Some roads and railways likely to be affected with longer journey times by road, bus and train services

Further details

Snow will be more persistent over higher ground with 5-10 cm above 200 m and a chance of locally 15 cm across the highest routes. There is also the possibility of a few slushy cm gathering locally at low levels, but away from the immediate coast.

As milder air pushes up from the south through the morning, snow across the south of the warning area and the Central Belt will become confined to hills, and slowly turn to rain again even on high ground here by late morning.
