

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Thursday 22 Oct 2009

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Organised rain, occasionally heavy, continuing across eastern Scotland for a while, but becoming confined to the far northeast later. Elsewhere, sunshine and showers, these heavy with a risk of thunder in the south and west. Mild, but rather breezy. Showers continuing in many areas overnight, but many inland areas becoming dry by morning, though rather misty.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Another showery day for Friday with most of the showers in the north and the east. More general cloud and rain will reach the southwest later. During Saturday, heavy rain and strong winds will spread northeastwards to all areas. It will remain generally mild.
