

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Wind and rain in northern England and southern Scotland moves northwards today, affecting only northeastern Scotland by evening. Other parts of the UK will see sunny spells and heavy, occasionally thundery showers throughout the day. Most parts will be dry overnight, although a few outbreaks of rain are expected over England and Scotland, these becoming heaviest in southern counties.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

It will remain unsettled with further showers or rain, but also spells of sunshine. Bright or sunny spells will be most widespread across central and southern parts of the UK during Thursday. Winds should remain light with temperatures close to normal.
