

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Occasional, mainly light rain, will affect northeast Scotland and the Northern Isles. Scattered showers will develop across the rest of Scotland and much of northern England, with the odd heavy one possible. Rain, accompanied by freshening southeasterly winds, will move northeast to affect much of England and Wales by dawn tomorrow. Temperatures will generally be around normal.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Most parts will see heavy showers or longer outbreaks of rain throughout Tuesday, with northwest Scotland and the Northern Isles staying drier. Further rain or showers on Wednesday for England and Wales, but drier and brighter in Scotland. Temperatures around normal.
