Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Mostly dry with some sunshine after a dull, misty start. However, isolated showers are possible across southern and northwestern Britain, some heavy, and heavy rain will affect the Northern Isles, where it will be breezy. Extensive low cloud, mist and hill fog will drift back across many central and eastern parts of the UK tonight, with drizzle in places.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Many eastern and northeastern parts of the UK will stay cloudy with patchy drizzle. It will be mostly dry elsewhere with warm sunny spells but isolated heavy, perhaps thundery showers are expected across southern areas, where it will be warm.
