Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
It will be a fine and sunny day across southern parts of the UK. In the north any early rain and hill snow will gradually become confined to northern parts of Northern Ireland and Scotland through the afternoon. Across the UK the westerly winds will be generally brisk, particularly at exposed coastlines and hills.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Monday will be unsettled with brisk westerly winds and outbreaks of occasionally heavy rain. Tuesday will be somewhat drier to start, with some bright spells in the east. However, further rain will spread from the west later. Temperatures, throughout, will be around or slightly above average.
