Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Scotland, very windy with gales, severe in the northwest, bringing heavy showers and sunny spells. Elsewhere, rather cloudy with light rain or drizzle but many eastern parts dry. Brighter spells developing but cloud increasing later and rain returning to the southwest by evening. Breezy. Tonight, in the south, mostly cloudy, rain at times. In the north, clear spells and showers.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Unsettled. Rain at times across southern areas, extending north on Tuesday. Further north, bright or sunny spells but also heavy showers, merging at times. Windy at times, especially in the south, with a risk of gales along English Channel coasts.
