

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A misty start with some patchy fog, then most central and eastern areas cloudy or dull with outbreaks of drizzly rain edging northwards. Western areas generally dry with bright intervals developing, though rain may reach Cornwall by evening. Tonight, cloudy. Rain spreading across western, then later central areas. Turning clearer in the southwest later.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Rain clearing eastwards on Friday leaving a much more cheerful day with some sunshine, but with showers in the west, these turning heavy later. After a bright start on Saturday, heavy rain and gale force winds will spread to many places during the day. Feeling chilly.
