General Situation

Pressure will remain high over the north, maintaining settled weather here. Further south various lows and associated fronts will bring much more unsettled conditions, with thundery showers or longer spells of rain expected in many areas, these very heavy in places.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less becoming east or northeast 3 to 5, veering east or southeast 2 to 4 later.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or southeast 2 to 4 backing east or northeast 3 to 5.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast backing northeast, 2 to 4, but increasing 5 for a time at first in Firth of Forth.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast 3 to 5.

Slight or moderate.

Showers later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 3 or 4, backing north 4 or 5 later.

Slight becoming moderate.

Fair, then rain or showers in south.

Good, occasionally moderate in south.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North backing northwest, 4 or 5.

Moderate.

Rain or showers, becoming fair for a time.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in south, then backing northerly later.

Moderate, occasionally slight at first in north.

Fair then rain, thundery at times.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly backing northwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in north,

decreasing 3 later in south.
Moderate, becoming slight in south.
Rain or showers, becoming fair for a time.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Northeasterly 5 or 6 becoming cyclonic 3 to 5.
Moderate, becoming slight or moderate.
Rain or thundery showers.
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Cyclonic 3 to 5 becoming westerly or northwesterly 4 to 6, becoming variable 2 to 4 later.
Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight later.
Rain or showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Northeasterly 3 to 5 becoming cyclonic 2 to 4, then becoming southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.
Slight or moderate, becoming smooth for a time at first in west.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwesterly 4 to 6, becoming cyclonic 2 to 4 later.
Moderate becoming slight.
Showers, then rain later.
Good, occasionally poor later.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Cyclonic 2 to 4 becoming southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in east and 3 in west.
Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight for a time at first.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwest 3 to 5 backing south 3 or 4, becoming variable 2 to 4 later.
Slight or moderate, becoming slight.
Showers, then rain later.
Good, occasionally poor later.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly
24 hour forecast:
Cyclonic 2 to 4 becoming southwest 3 to 5.
Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight for a time at first in lyme bay.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwest 2 to 4 becoming cyclonic 3 to 5, then becoming west or northwest later.
Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight for a time later in lyme bay.
Rain or showers.
Good, occasionally poor.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel
24 hour forecast:
East or southeast 3 to 5 becoming cyclonic 2 to 4, then becoming south or

southwest later.
Slight or moderate becoming smooth or slight.
Thundery showers.
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwest becoming variable, then northwest later, 2 to 4.
Smooth or slight, becoming moderate later near Cornwall.
Showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel
24 hour forecast:
Easterly or northeasterly 3 to 5, becoming variable 2 or 3 later except in far north.
Slight or moderate near northern Anglesey, smooth or slight elsewhere.
Rain or thundery showers.
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Easterly or northeasterly 4 at first in far north, otherwise variable 3 or less.
Moderate at first near northern Anglesey, otherwise smooth or slight.
Occasional rain then showers.
Good, occasionally poor at first.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
East or northeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in Solway Firth, decreasing 3 at times elsewhere.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in west.
Fair until later in north, otherwise rain or showers.
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
East or northeast 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less for a time.
Smooth or slight.
Rain then fair.
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Isle of Man
24 hour forecast:
East or northeast 3 to 5, becoming variable 2 at times later.
Slight.
Fair then occasional rain.
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northeast 3 or 4 becoming variable 3 or less.
Slight, becoming smooth or slight.
Fair.
Good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough
24 hour forecast:
East 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, then becoming variable 2 at times.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate at first in southeast.
Rain for a time later in southeast.
Good, occasionally moderate later in southeast.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
East 3 or 4 becoming variable 3 or less.
Smooth or slight.
Mainly fair.
Good.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or northeasterly 3 to 5, becoming variable 2 to 4 for a time.

Smooth or slight.

Rain for a time later in far south.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less for a time.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:

Easterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first in far south, then becoming variable 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight.

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, becoming variable 3 or less later.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, becoming variable 2 to 4 later.

Slight, occasionally smooth between barra and canna.

Fair.

Variable 2 to 4 becoming east or northeast 3 to 5.

Slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Anticyclone remains slow moving over the Northern North Sea, while a weak Atlantic front will affect the north of Shetland Waters at first.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil

West becoming variable, 3 or less.
Slight, but smooth in lee shelter just east of Shetland.
Mainly fair, but occasional rain at first in north.
Good, occasionally moderate at first in north.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Sunday 05 Jun until 0600 UTC on Monday 06 Jun:

Variable 3 or less.
Slight, but smooth in lee shelter just east of Shetland.
Mainly fair.
Mainly good.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

West 2 to 4, perhaps locally variable at times, backing southwest 3 to 5 by evening.
Slight, locally smooth, perhaps occasionally moderate mid-channel.
Mist and a risk of fog patches, clearing northeastward by midday, then isolated showers in the afternoon and evening, mainly in south, perhaps heavy and thundery near the brittany coast.
Good, locally moderate or poor at times, perhaps locally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 3 to 5, backing south 2 to 4 for a time.
Smooth or slight, perhaps locally moderate at times, with a low swell developing.
Rain and drizzle, perhaps locally heavy, spreading in from the south by midday, clearing northwards overnight.
Good becoming moderate, locally poor, for a time.

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
