

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Friday 08 May 2015

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Mostly dry at first but wet and windy weather in the southwest will spread  
northeastwards through the day with heavy rain at times. Scotland will remain  
cooler and brighter with scattered showers. Whilst the persistent rain will  
clear overnight, patchy rain will continue across some parts with showery rain  
spreading east later. Staying clearer and colder across parts of Scotland.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Unsettled on Saturday with rain or showers and breezy in the south. Showers will  
be locally heavy and thundery but will ease from the west later. Sunday will be  
wet and windy in the northwest but sunnier and warmer elsewhere.
