Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
There will be sunny spells for most but also some scattered showers in the north, perhaps falling as snow over the hills. It will be windy, with gales or severe gales in the far northeast. Overnight it should stay largely dry, with some frost possible in the west, whilst it will be breezy near the east coast, with showers possible.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:  
Northwestern parts will turn cloudier through Saturday morning with rain and drizzle. Elsewhere it will be mainly dry with sunny spells. Sunday should be generally cloudy with the best of any breaks in the southeast and some drizzle across Scotland.
