

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Mist and fog may linger in northeast England, otherwise soon becoming bright with good sunny spells for most. Feeling warm in the sunshine, but cooler near southern and eastern coasts in a southeasterly breeze. Thickening cloud and patchy rain will spread erratically north and east overnight. Many northern parts mostly dry with clear spells and a local frost.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:  
Generally rather cloudy with rain and drizzle, persistent at times with some hill and coastal fog. Perhaps drier in the south later on Thursday. Feeling cool in the wind and rain, especially in the northeast. A risk of hill snow in Scotland.
