

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Thursday 20 Sep 2007

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain will push south across Scotland during today, especially western parts. Elsewhere will be rather cloudy with occasional sunny spells, and some showery outbreaks of rain, especially in the west. Breezy, but generally rather warm. Largely dry with clear spells over Scotland tonight. Rather cloudy but mild elsewhere with some rain, probably becoming heavy across north Wales and northwest England.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Rain, some heavy, across northern England and Wales will edge south during Friday. Largely dry elsewhere, although some showers will affect northwest Scotland. Generally breezy. Rain in the southeast and north on Saturday, otherwise largely fine with temperatures around normal.
