

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 1945 on Monday 04 Mar 2013

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Early mist and fog should clear by late morning, leaving much of the UK dry with plenty of sunshine. In light winds it should feel pleasant, with the highest temperatures likely to the north of London and across sheltered parts of west Wales. Northern Ireland will see a sunnier day compared to Monday. Cloudier in the far southwest later.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Becoming rather more unsettled, with predominantly cloudy conditions and outbreaks of rain sporadically pushing northwards. Low cloud and hill fog is likely to become quite extensive, and easterly winds will also strengthen and make it feel quite cold across northern Britain.
