Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Mostly dry at first, although there may be patches of frost and fog in places, with some icy stretches in Northern Ireland and Scotland in the morning. Rain in the southwest will spread northwards, reaching most parts by evening, with some heavy, thundery bursts possible. Further hill snow is expected in Scotland. Turning drier from the southwest later.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Most areas should stay dry through Wednesday and Thursday, with some bright or sunny spells, particularly in the east, and breezy southeasterly winds. Outbreaks of rain may affect some western parts however, with a chance of hill snow in the north.
