

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Friday 01 Feb 2008

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Frequent wintry showers spreading southwards through the day, turning to snow at low levels with locally heavy flurries over hills. Some southern parts may stay dry. Feeling very cold in strong northwesterly winds. Overnight, wintry showers continuing in the north and west, although many southern and eastern areas becoming dry with a sharp frost forming. Northwesterly winds will ease later.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Further wintry flurries will affect northern and western areas at times, with the south and east largely dry with some sunshine. Winds backing to the southwest and increasing. Conditions will become drier on Saturday and milder with winds backing southwesterly.
